### **About the Job**

To succeed in this role, you will;

- Possess the ability to effectively interpret between Auslan and spoken English.
- Have a strong understanding of Auslan and Deaf culture.
- Hold NAATI certification in Auslan/English interpreting.
- Demonstrate a sound knowledge of the ASLIA Code of Ethics
- Accurately complete assigned tasks/duties, and paperwork promptly and within approved guidelines.
- Possess the ability to work effectively in a fast paced, dynamic environment that is customer service focused.
- Work effectively in a team environment; receive support from and provide support to colleagues.
- Demonstrate willingness and ability to complete additional duties and assignments on an ongoing basis.
- Enhance your interpreting skills through continued education and training.

### Special Conditions:

- The ability to maintain a flexible work schedule, in order to meet the demands, is essential.
- Work will predominantly take place between Monday – Friday, 8am – 6pm however there will be times when out of hours work is required.
- Current driver's licence is essential.
- Current Police Clearance no greater than 6 months old and ability to obtain Working with Children's Check is required.
